All entry forms to be submitted to the Secretary by Wednesday 5th August 2026

Entry forms received after this date will be late entries and will be £1 per item.

No entry forms will be accepted after 10 a.m. on 9 August 2026

Vintage Mechanical Field late entries no later than 11:00 am.

Entry money, once paid will not be refunded.

No entries to be substituted.

All exhibits must have been made or grown by the exhibitor and not exhibited previously at the Staintondale & Ravenscar Show

All exhibits to be at Ravenscar Village Hall from 8 a.m. and strictly no later than 10.30 am on the morning of the show.

Vintage Mechanical Field Exhibits, including cars, no later than 11 am.

All exhibits must be placed in the correct section by the exhibitor and are displayed at owner's risk.

Exhibits in Section 2 to be displayed on plain white doilies or paper plates - No identifying markings, except class 22 'afternoon tea' - presentation exhibitor's choice.

The hall will remain closed for judging until 2 pm.

Any prize money not collected on the day will be deemed not wanted and taken back into funds.

All disputes to be decided by the Committee and not subject to proceedings by law.

All dogs must be kept on a lead and no dogs allowed in the hall.

Exhibits not to be removed until 4 pm.

All trophies to be returned to the committee by 1 July 2027

Set Recipe : Lemon Drizzle Cake

225g unsalted butter softened	Drizzle Topping:
225g caster sugar	Juice of two lemons
4 eggs	85g caster sugar
225g self-raising flour	
Zest of two lemons	

Grease and line a 2lb loaf tin (appr 14 x 24 cm)

Heat oven to 180c/fan 160c/gas 4

Beat butter and sugar together until pale and creamy then add the eggs, flour and lemon zest. Mix until well combined then spoon into loaf tin and level the top. Bake in the centre of the oven for 45-50 minutes. Insert a skewer into middle of cake. If it comes out clean remove from oven but leave in tin and prick all over with a skewer. Mix the lemon juice and sugar and pour gently over the warm cake. Leave in the tin to cool completely.
